

## CLOSED HEARING ORDER HEARING BLOCK 4 (1 – 9 MARCH 2023)

## **ORDERS:**

In accordance with s 24 of the *Inquiries Act 2014* (Vic), having regard to the matters set out in sections 24(1)(b), (d) and (e) of the *Inquiries Act 2014* (Vic):

- 1. At Yoorrook's discretion, part or all of a witness' evidence may be led in a 'closed' hearing, whereby:
  - a. members of the public (including members of the media), parties with leave to appear and/or all non-essential staff are requested to leave the hearing room;
  - b. Yoorrook's live stream is paused; and/or
  - c. the relevant evidence is omitted from published video recordings.
- 2. A copy of this order is to be:
  - a. posted on the door of the place where the proceeding is being conducted at the time of the closed hearing; and
  - b. published on Yoorrook's website: https://yoorrookjusticecommission.org.au/

## Notes:

1. Pursuant to section 48(1) of the *Inquiries Act 2014* (Vic), it is an indictable offence for a person (including a body corporate) to knowingly or recklessly contravene an order of a Commissioner under section 24(1).
