'Victoria' is a politically constituted geographical area
that was named thus on 1st of July 1851.
Victoria is a Latin word meaning 'Victory'.

The then 'Colony of Victoria' was named in honour of Queen Victoria
whom the invaders alleged was the Sovereign at the time of the Constitution of Victoria.

In 1992, the myth of Terra Nullius was overturned by British Common Law
(a fiction that was always understood as such by First Peoples)
which recognised that these lands called Australia
were a Sovereign Land before colonisation.

June 2022 the newly elected Albanese Labor government has pledged a commitment to implementing
the Uluru Statement from the Heart and Linda Burney is the first Indigenous woman to hold the position
of Minister for Indigenous Australians. Unlike EVERY OTHER BRITISH COLONY,
Australia is yet to make a Treaty with the First Peoples of this Land. We are at a point in history where
hope and struggle for a better future is beckoning.

I pay my deep respects to the Elders Past, Present and Emerging
and all First Peoples of this Land.

I salute your Resistance and Defiance and hope that
Justice will be achieved.....
